TEXAS PHILATELIC CHECKLIST

Texas celebrated its statehood sesquicentennial in 1995. James C. Taylor of Havre de Grace, Maryland has generously donated to the Texas Philatelic Association the rights to his "Texas Philatelic Checklist." Mr. Taylor's checklist was the foundation of the *The Texas Philatelist's* 1995 statehood sesquicentennial commemoration as was Norma Watz's "Sesquicentennial Cover Trail: Texas 1986" for the 150th anniversary of the Republic of Texas.

Mr. Taylor explains that most of the earlier issues cover figures involved in Texas history, the Mexican War, and other Texas adventures up to World War I. John J. Pershing, for example, led the expedition against Pancho Villa in 1915. Robert E. Lee was commander of the Army's Department of Texas based in San Antonio in the early 1850s, as well as the Mexican War and Confederacy connections. Franklin D. Roosevelt opened the 1936 centennial year Texas State Fair in Dallas. Will Rogers was part of a wild west circus for several years in Fort Worth. Such are the Texas connections of some of the less obvious historical figures.

Other examples of Texas connections follow:

- (874) John James Audubon painted extensively in East Texas near Beaumont, and several of his works hang in a Beaumont museum.
- (929) Iwo Jima group of men raising the United States flag includes Corporal Bloch from Weslaco.
- (937) Alfred E. Smith was nominated by the 1928 Democratic convention in Houston.
- (988) Samuel P. Gompers died in San Antonio in 1922.
- (1319) Great River Road, part of which was the then navigable Red River, made Jefferson in East Texas quite a port in the 1880s.
- (1187) Frederick Remington's painting hangs in the Carter Museum, Fort Worth
- (2121) Lightning Whelk seashell, Texas state shell, was designated so by the 1987 legislature.
- (2186) General Clair Lee Chennault was born in Commerce, Texas.
- (C49) United States Air Force, born in 1947, obviously takes into account the Army Air Corps born at Fort Sam Houston, San Antonio in 1909.
- (C95) Wiley Post was born in Grand Saline, Texas.
- (UX95) Rene Robert Cavalier, Sieur de la Salle, was killed in a mutiny (1687) near present-day Navasota, Texas and is buried there.

All astronauts listed are Texas-born. Sources for information are the official astronaut biographical sketches from the National Aeronautics and Space Admin-

istration.

Wildlife listed are all those indigenous or commonly found in Texas. Military figures are those who had a part in Texas history or who are Texas-born. Most of the Army men spent significant parts of their careers based in Texas. Beside his obvious Texas birth connection, several landmarks of Dwight D. Eisenhower's military career occurred in Texas: (1) Fort Sam Houston (San Antonio) was his first assignment out of West Point in 1915, where he courted and married Mamie Geneva Doud; (2) he was promoted to first lieutenant; and (3) his first son, Dwight Doud nicknamed "Icky," was born.

Most of the First Day of Issues are that only. They are noted because of a Texas FDOI site.

All sports figures are either Texas-born, or have played for Texas teams. Birth places or names of teams are noted.

The "Texas Philatelic Checklist" needs updating. None of the U.S. issues since 1993 have been thoroughly checked, although some additions have been made for some of the more obvious releases to early-2009. The foreign list has very few additions made since the early 1990s. Corrections, additions and correspondence regarding any stamp issues relating to Texas will be gratefully received and acknowledged.
